

Victory Day

The Victory Day holiday is approaching us. I consider, it is my duty to tell about the sights located in my city Syktyvkar. This monument is called *the Eternal Flame*.

The opening ceremony of the monument took place on August 20, 1981. This is a memorial complex in honor of soldiers who died in Syktyvkar during the Great Patriotic War.

The image of three mourning women represents the wife, the daughter and the mother of a soldier. The woman, standing in the center, is bringing to the bowl a cedar branch wrapped with ribbons. Next to the monument there are objects in the form of defensive fences. On them you can find immortalized names of soldiers who fell in the battle, died of wounds and missing. The names of warriors are constantly being added to the monument. Next to the elevation in a special niche there are the volumes of "Books of Memory of the Komi Republic" and the appeal to the descendants of 2045.



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
